Joe R. Brand Victim of Fatal Accident at Pea Ridge Mine

Our community was shocked and saddened Wednesday evening when word was received that Joe R. Brand had been the victim of a fatal accident which occurred in the Pea Ridge Mine at Sullivan. Joe had gone to work on the night shift, and, according to information received by us, a ceiling check had been made which indicated it was safe for drilling. However, when he began to drill, the first vibration caused a huge stone to fall, which struck him, causing his death.

Joe was a young man of

stature in his church and in his dealings with everyone, and the shock and grief at his tragic passing was shared by a great host of family and friends, who expressed their concern by gathering with his immediate family at the funeral home where he lay in state, as well as in the floral tributes and memorial gifts.

We, too, as members of his relationship, and speaking for the community we serve, would extend to his wife, children, parents, and relatives, our heartfelt sympathy and concern.



Joe Richard Brand, dear son of Floy Brand and Hazel Hutson (nee Ivie) was born October 20, 1938 in Steelville, and suddenly was taken from this life December 18, 1974 in Sullivan, Mo., at the age of 36 years, 1 month, and 28 days.

December 3, 1960 in Advance, Mo., Joe was united in marriage to Charlotte Martin. To this union four sons were born.
