'In addition to the cemeteries at Brookfield Center and Paynes Corners, it was said that there was still another cemetery in the township. This is not so. Apparently those believing that there was still another burial area must have reference to the plot of ground on the land in the northwest vicinity of Slope Road known in the 1860's as Whiteacre Woods. This portion of land was under the control of the Masie Coal Company who obtained it from Hermann Whiteacre. No one knows the exact events that led to the burial of the wife of Henry Gandy in this area but Henry was the elected appraiser of the township in its first election and he was on the board concerning the cemetery that was already established at the center. There are several other burials in Whiteacre Woods but no record has ever been kept and no permanent markers were used on the graves. With the passing of time the exact spot has completely vanished.'

In Part: 'The first death in the township of which there is any record, was that of Mrs. Henry Gandy. The body was interred in the woods, a short distance south of the present Whiteare coal bank.'
