George Calvin Martin of Cuba, Mo. was born on July 12, 1925, at Cuba, Mo. to the union of William Edward Martin and Anna Adele (Hamilton) Martin and passed away at his home near Cuba, Mo. on November 4, 2002 at the age of 77 years, 3 months and 22 days.

On December 15, 1944, George entered the Army of the United States of America and honorably served his country during World War II and was discharged on October 14, 1947.

On December 8, 1948, George was united in marriage to Mabel Mullen. One daughter, Judy, and one son, Kevin, were born to this union. They were happily married for 53 years.
