Born in Gloucester County, NJ 1745

Died August 15, 1819

Father: Andrew Ware

Mother: Rachel Ware

Married to Sarah Marple April 6, 1767

- **John Ware Sr. died August 15, 1819 at his homestead in Waretown, Gloucester county New Jersey (Waretown is now called Sickerville, Camden County, New Jersey) and was buried in The Marple-Zane graveyard near Clement's bridge (Ashbrook Burial Ground in Glendora, Camden County, New Jersey).**
- **John and Sarah had seven children, John Jr., George, Joseph, Patience, Jacob, Isaiah and Andrew M. Ware.**
- **John Ware Sr. was a Revolutionary Soldier – Private 2nd Class in Captain Maddox Company, Gloucester Co NJ 1775 - 1780.**

- **Married Sarah Marple April 6, 1767 information from the Swedes' Church in Philadelphia.**
