- Death notice list Lizzie Savage with a Social Security number issue before 1951 in Illinois. List her last residence as Venice, ILL, her birth date as January 27, 1882 and she died April 1967. This birth date is the same as Nettie Trinkler (sister) which we have a record for and is quite younger then the different census. We have retained our first birth year that we got off of a census for 1880.
- 1940 Census list still another name change for Lizzie Johnson to Lillie Johnson. She still has Arthur Jr. and Jasper Johnson living with her even though both are in their 20s. She still resides in Venice, ILL.
- We have some photos that show Lizzie with a daughter Bea Johnson so we are sure Lizzie is within our Trinkler family but we are not sure if the 1900 census, her birth

date or if we have associated Lizzie with Louisa incorrectly. We only have record of Christina and Louisa and do not know what their middle names may be. I do have pictures of Christina and Lizzie but not able to tell if they are the same. There is nothing on Louisa other than census information.

- Arthur Johnson died January 10, 1924 and was buried in New Bethleham, MO.
- The 1910 Census list the same family under Arthur Johnson instead of James Arthur Savage. All estimated ages are within the right period and his Mother Catherine Johnson is living with them so it appears as there is a name change. However, the 1918 Registration card still indicates Savage. They have four additional children, Marion 9, Iva 6, Arthur 3 and Jasper L. Johnson as 6/12th. We have pictures with information referring to Lizzie's name as Savage and Johnson. We also have pictures of Jasper L. Johnson with our other family members. Buela is not listed here and she would have only been 10. One possible guess is that maybe Marion and Buela are one and the same. Since they appear to remain under a different identity.
- 12/6/1918 Lizzie is listed as James Savage's wife on his Registration card.
- 1902 James Arthur Savage gets a divorce from Margaret Hilbert. James did not appear in court for the divorce as the divorce was over his affair with Lizzie Trinkler. It appears that James Arthur Savage hid from the court and moved to Venice, ILL and marries Lizzie Trinkler. In addition, they both are now known as the Johnsons.
- 1900 census there is a Catherine Johnson listed as head of household and she has her son James Arthur Savage, Lizzie Trinkler and Lizzie's infant baby 0/12 living with her. Lizzie is shown as 20 years old. Our assumption is

that Lizzie is Louisa, however her given census age may be closer to her sister Christina Trinkler. But all ages are taken from census which are not always correct.

- Louisa was around 8 when her mother died and her father had already married Catherine Uhrich. Not sure where she went or who she lived with as a child.
- Fredericka Trinkler, Louisa's mother (Charles wife before Kate) dies on August 13, 1887 at 3203 n 6th street Saint Louis, MO
- No record but if you go by the census Lousia's father remarried to Catherine Uhrich about 1884.
- No record of a divorce of Louisa's parents Fredericka and Charles however, there is a record of a birth of Kate Trinkler May 9, 1884 to George (believe to be an Uncle to Charles and who they lived with in 1880) and Fredericka. Assumption is that Charles and Fredericka got a divorce.
- June 1880 census, Charles Trinkler, lived on 3203 2nd Street Saint Louis, Mo with George Trinkler 1831 49 years old (believed to be Uncle of Charles), Katherine Smith 21 years old, her son George Smith 6 years old, Charles wife Henrika 31 years old, Charles/Henrika's Children, George age 13, Christine age 8, Rosine age 6 and Louisa age 1.
