

## **Rosine Trinkler**



**Born in Saint Louis, MO August 1874**

**Died Unknown**

**Father: Charles Trinkler**

**Mother: Henrika Lumonstom**

**Married to Tom Reynolds**

### **Records in hand**

- **Rose and Thomas Reynolds were on Irene Hercules Trinkler's Funeral Register dated June 17<sup>th</sup> 1953.**
- **No records other than some photos that show Rose with a Tom Reynolds as married. We have some photos of an Irene (Young) Steffen, husband is William Steffen. Not sure if she is Rose's daughter or the Irene Rose lived with who is her half sister. The assumption is made that she is Rose's daughter.**
- **Rosa last shows up in the 1900 Census living with Catherine (Uhrich) Trinkler as head of household. Her father Charles is not on the census with them at this time. She is shown as 24 at this time.**
- **Fredericka Trinkler, Rosa mother (Charles wife before Kate) dies on August 13, 1887 at 3203 n 6<sup>th</sup> street Saint Louis, MO**

- **No record but if you go by the census Rosa's father remarried to Catherine Uhrich about 1884.**
- **No record of a divorce of Rosa's parents Fredericka and Charles however, there is a record of a birth of Kate Trinkler May 9, 1884 to George (believe to be an Uncle to Charles and who they lived with in 1880) and Fredericka. Assumption is that Charles and Fredericka got a divorce.**
- **June 1880 census, Charles Trinkler, lived on 3203 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Saint Louis, Mo with George Trinkler 1831 49 years old (believed to be Uncle of Charles), Katherine Smith 21 years old, her son George Smith 6 years old, Charles wife Henrika 31 years old, Charles/Henrika's Children, George age 13, Christine age 8, Rosine age 6 and Louisa age 1.**
